- **Teachers (15%)** absenteeism, tenure, salaries, student-teacher ratio, surveys...
- Culture & Diversity (10%) including race, gender, and economically disadvantaged, surveys...
- **Health & Safety (5%)** student absenteeism, cost per student, suspensions, surveys...
- **Resources/Facilities (5%)** cost per student, student-counselor ratio, student-teacher ratio, surveys
- Clubs & Activities (2.5%) cost per student, student-teacher ratio, sports, surveys...
- **Sports (2.5%)** enrollment, # of sports offered, participation, championships, surveys...
- Overall Feedback (10%) surveys from parents and students on their overall experience
